Aldie, VA—Mr. David Hoffman, a resident of Stone Ridge, was recently named as John Champe High School's English Department Chair. A teacher at Loudoun Valley High School, Mr. Hoffman presently teaches Advanced Placement Literature and English 11. He holds a Master of Science in Educational Administration from Shenandoah University and has completed advanced coursework in the areas of Medieval Drama and in the Integration of Technology in Schools. In addition to being a Master Teacher for Shepherd University's English Education Program for the past six years, Mr. Hoffman has served on the LCPS English Honors Assessment and Benchmark committees and has acted as Best Practices Instructor for the LCPS Mentor Office. Mr. Hoffman is also one of five teacher leaders in the county building the English Honors Curriculum. As the sponsor of the Forensics team, Mr. Hoffman coached his students to a district championship (Cedar Run District) in 2011 (as well as being state participants in 2008 and 2009), and he also serves his school community as the sponsor of the National Honor Society.
